The North Chapel is available for prayer before the service.

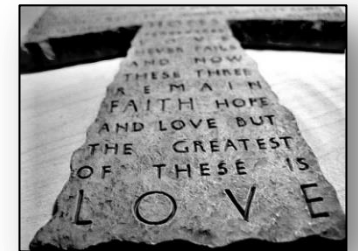
