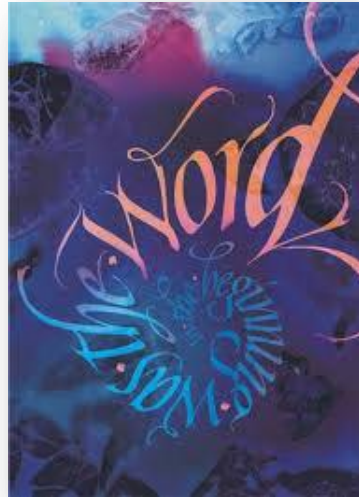


You're the Word of God the Father,
