“Practising the way of Jesus”

What’s the idea?

The idea of the “Practising the way of Jesus” DVD course is to help you:

- **look afresh** at your own discipleship.
- consider **what influences** your discipleship
- **be excited** about what the Biblical understanding of transformation could look like for you.

Who’s it for?

“Practising the way of Jesus” is for anyone who:

- recognises they need a journey of transformation towards becoming more Christ-like, and
- wants to look at their own discipleship in a practical and thought-provoking way.

What’s the format?

As part of the 10am Sunday morning service there will be an (almost) **fortnightly DVD presentation** of the main Bible teaching talks by Jon Mark Comer, recorded at New Wine 2017.

Each DVD lasts approx. 30 - 40 minutes.

To allow for this the service order will be adjusted to allow time for communion to be shared as part of the usual pattern of worship.

The whole service should last no longer than usual – finishing around 11.15am.

In addition, each presentation will be repeated on a Wednesday at 11am (after the 10am Communion Service).

What’s the cost?

Nothing...it is free!

Will I have to ‘join in’?

There is no expectation to ‘join in’ any more than you are comfortable with – it’s a DVD presentation.

We hope there will be conversations afterwards which you are welcome to be part of as much as you like – or just sit back quietly and listen. The choice is yours!
