and trembles at his voice.

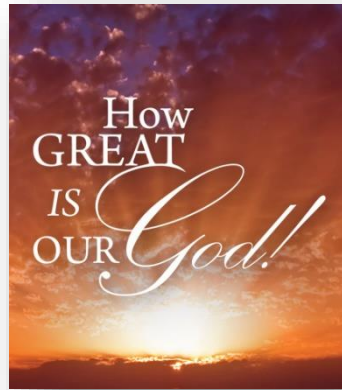
